

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Wheeling, West Virginia will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, April 2, 2013 at 12 noon in Wheeling City Council Chambers located on the first floor of the City-County Building, 1500 Chapline Street, Wheeling, West Virginia. The purpose of the hearing is to solicit comment on a proposal to reprogram Fiscal Year 2012 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds.

The City proposes to make needed repairs to the Schenk Bridge located on Schenk Street in Fulton. Funding would come, in part, from the following Fiscal Year 2012 CDBG line items:
