City Council Meetings Rescheduled Due to Holidays *City Offices Closed on June 20, July 4*

WHEELING, W.Va. – Due to upcoming holidays, the next two meetings of Wheeling City Council will deviate from the regular schedule of the first and third Tuesday of the month. Council will meet on Wednesday, June 21, at 5:30 p.m. and Wednesday, July 5, at 12:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.

The City of Wheeling administrative offices will be closed on Tuesday, June 20, for West Virginia Day, and Tuesday, July 4, for Independence Day. Sanitation and recycling services are not affected by the June 20 holiday. However, the landfill will not open on Tuesday, July 4, which will affect the trash collection schedule for the rest of that week.

City services will operate as follows:

- Sanitation/Recycling Departments will operate as scheduled the week of June 19-23.
- Sanitation/Recycling Departments will be closed on Tuesday, July 4, due to the landfill being closed. Trash and recycling pick-up will be delayed by one day beginning Tuesday of that week. Neighborhoods regularly scheduled for Friday trash collection can expect collection on Saturday.
- All Police, Fire, and Emergency Services operate 24 hours a day and will be functioning as normal.
