**FY 2015 CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE  
AND EVALUATION REPORT (C.A.P.E.R.)**

In accordance with Title 1 of the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, P.L. 101-625, the City of Wheeling has prepared its Fiscal Year 2015 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation report (C.A.P.E.R.) for its Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) and the Home Investment Partnership Program (HOME). This report describes the level of housing assistance and other community development activities designed to benefit low - and moderate-income persons and households through various federal funding programs during Fiscal Year 2015 (July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016).

The City will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, September 6, 2016 at 12:00 Noon, prevailing time, in the Council Chambers located on the first floor of the City-County Building, 1500 Chapline Street, Wheeling, West Virginia 26003. The City-County Building is accessible to persons with physical disabilities. The purpose of the public hearing will be to obtain citizens comments on the C.A.P.E.R. document.

The City of Wheeling intends to submit the FY 2015 C.A.P.E.R. to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on or before September 28, 2016.
