WHEELING CITY CLERK HONORED AT MUNICIPAL LEAGUE CONFERENCE

Wheeling, WV – Earlier in August, Wheeling City Clerk, Janice Jones, was named West Virginia Clerk/Recorder of the Year at the West Virginia Municipal League Summer Conference. Jones is the first clerk in the history of the organization to receive this honor twice.

Ms. Jones has been with the City of Wheeling since 1985, and was appointed City Clerk in 1994. She is Past President of the West Virginia Clerk and Records Association and has been on the WV Municipal League's Board of Directors since 2000. She has also served on the League's Conference Planning Committee and Credentials Committee for the past 20 years.

In 2000, Ms. Jones earned her Certified Municipal Clerk Certification (CMC) – one of nine in the state – from the International Institute of Municipal Clerks, and she is nearing completion of her Master Municipal Clerk Certification (MMC).

Jones was honored at the West Virginia Municipal League conference, which was held at Snowshoe Resort on August 8-10, 2012.

The West Virginia Municipal League is a statewide, nonprofit, nonpartisan association of cities, towns and villages established in 1968 to assist local governments and advance the interests of the citizens who reside within.
