

NOTICE

Wheeling City Council will hold a special meeting on Tuesday, November 29, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wheeling Park White Palace Building, second floor, 1801 National Road, Wheeling, WV. The purpose of the meeting is to hold a public hearing on the proposed non-discrimination amendments to the City's Human Rights Commission, Article 169 of the Codified Laws. Thereafter, Council may consider placing such amendments and/or modifications thereof, on a Council Agenda for action.

Designated sign-up sheets will be available at 5:00 p.m., one hour prior to the hearing, at the Wheeling Park White Palace Building. Public comments will be strictly limited to a maximum of three (3) minutes per speaker. Persons wishing to be heard will be required to sign-up in categories: City of Wheeling residents and employers/property owners to be heard first; Ohio County, WV persons/tenants - second; State of West Virginia person/entities - third; and all others - fourth. Interested parties may appear at the above mentioned public hearing scheduled at the City Council special meeting on November 29, 2016 and be heard with respect to the proposed anti-discrimination amendments to the City's Human Rights Commission Laws and the proposed ordinance with amendments
