“PUBLIC HEARING - PROPOSED NON-DISCRIMINATION AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY’S HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION - ARTICLE 169 OF THE CODIFIED LAWS.”

Public comments were received from City of Wheeling residents, Ohio County residents, State of West Virginia residents and all others, both for and against the proposed amendment to the City of Wheeling’s Human Rights Commission’s anti-discrimination ordinance. Mayor Elliott and council members will take the comments under consideration. Approximately 33 spoke in favor of the proposed ordinance and approximately 9 spoke against the proposed ordinance.

Mayor Elliott indicated that the first reading of this ordinance will take place at the December 6, 2016 with the final reading on December 20, 2016.
