

A Resolution in Support of City of Wheeling Application for WV Land & Water Conservation Fund Resources for the Renovation of Edgington Lane Park Project

WHEREAS, the City of Wheeling, WV seeks to create enhanced opportunities for citizens and families to utilize and enjoy outdoor park and recreational areas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wheeling has created a vision for the renovation of Edgington Lane Park for the community's recreational enjoyment by the public; and

WHEREAS, Edgington Lane Park is a small park in the core of Woodsdale, and despite its size this park is a staple of recreational activity and has an important place in the hearts of its neighbors

WHEREAS, the City of Wheeling has an available match to cover 50% of the amount of the proposed renovation project, in the amount of up to \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wheeling authorizes the submission of an application to the State of West Virginia requesting funding for the above-mentioned project out of the Land and Water Conservation Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wheeling agrees to abide by all rules and regulations pertaining to the Land and Water Conservation Fund Program, and to operate and maintain the proposed facility for public use under the requirements of the Land and Water Conservation Fund should this project receive federal assistance;

NOW, THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the City of Wheeling authorize an application by the City for a WV Land & Water Conservation Fund, and the City authorizes a match in the amount up to \$250,000
