

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE November 19, 2024

The Public Works Committee of Wheeling City Council met on the above date at 5 p.m. in City Council Chambers. Committee members present: Vice Chair Sklavounakis, Chair Thorngate and Member Seidler Others present: City Manager Robert Herron, Lori Siburt, Water Superintendent, Councilors Cain, Palmer, Assaro and Mayor Denny Magruder, City Clerk Jessica Zalenski, members of the press and public.

The following matter was discussed:

Discussion Water System Improvements:

Chair Thorngate called the meeting to order at 4:15pm.

City Manager Herron introduced Lori Siburt, Water Superintendent and representatives from CT Consultants to give an overview of the improvements needed. Additionally with these improvements, a rate increase would be needed to sustain. Dan Barr Project Manager for CT Consultants gave a presentation on the scope of work including Mozart and Clearview Booster Replacements, Atlas- Caramel- Grandview-Oglebay-Leewood and Boggs Hill and additionally updates to the Water Treatment Plant. Estimated total to complete these phases would be \$19.8 million, with the Boggs Hill Booster station that services residents up in Oglebay as a top priority. Discussions continued. City Manager Herron recommended waiting for further information that would include sewer improvements before sending recommendations to council. No motions were made, a future meeting will be held to discuss additional improvements.

There being no further business to come before the Committee, Mr. Sklavounakis, seconded by Mr. Seidler moved to adjourn. Time: 4:43 p.m.
