Public Hearing for GC&P Development Set for July 13

Wheeling, W. Va. — The City of Wheeling's Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing

regarding the GC&P Development proposal to amend the comprehensive plan's future land use plan to

allow development of a mixed-use village in Woodsdale. The hearing is being held at 6 p.m., July 13 at

the White Palace in Wheeling Park and doors open at 5 p.m.

In August of 2019, GC&P Development, LLC approached the Wheeling Planning Commission

proposing to develop a 50-plus acre property along West Virginia Route 88. They proposed significantly

altering the topography of the property in order to develop the land to include residential, dining,

entertainment, office, institutional, retail and hospitality uses.

Following the governor's COVID-19 protective guidelines, the venue capacity will be reduced to

100 people, but a first-floor overflow room will provide room for 50 more people.

If citizens do not feel comfortable attending the meeting in person but wish to attend and

express an opinion, it will be streamed virtually via a Zoom meeting. All comments are limited to three
